


ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2018



CESTA DOMŮ'S MISSION

Cesta domů is a non-profit organisation that, through the services of a mobile hospice, enables terminally ill and dying children and adults to be cared for in their natural environment and offers support to their loved ones.

At the same time, it seeks to contribute to social and legislative changes that aim to improve care for the dying. It offers educational activities, runs web portals, produces publications and has a specialist library.

Together we share and publicly assert the acceptance that dying is a natural part of life.

INTRODUCTION

Cesta domů has been a part of people's lives for eighteen years. We move in the private space of patients and their families, in borderline and difficult situations that nobody chooses, but inherently belong to life.

We want people, who wish it, to be able to die at home, where they like it and where they do not feel alone. We support their families in taking care of their loved ones and having time at the end of their lives filled not only with worries and stress, but also with the chance to get together, reminisce and say goodbye.

We are also trying to promote changes in the approach to dying in Czech society, leading to better information, lessening taboos and strengthening awareness that the time spent with the sick and the dying often resembles an unexpectedly discovered treasure.

In 2018, we have continued to do everything that Cesta domů has been doing for a long time: we have offered mobile hospice services, counselling, respite services, a support team and the rental of equipment. We have introduced and gradually expanded the palliative ambulance service and are developing palliative care for child patients. We have provided internet counselling to the public; we have also communicated through websites and social networks. The publishers and the charity shops have done well, and the café has continued to operate. Many people interested in the subject of palliative care have used what our library has to offer or have attended lectures and study days.

We are very grateful especially to the employees of Cesta domů and our invaluable volunteers for everything that is happening. But also, we could not have managed without the help of a wide range of supporters, whose generosity we do not take for granted and is much appreciated. In the past year, a lot of energy was required during the handover of the director's position – until the end of August Marek Uhlíř was in charge of Cesta domů and since September I have taken on that role with joy and respect. Thank you, to everyone who has helped and still is helping me.

Cesta domu's life is varied, we try to understand the changing needs and demand for our help and to respond to them with new ideas on how to further improve the service. You can read about most of what is happening here on the pages of the annual report, but much of our work remains hidden, which does not mean it is any less important.

I would like to thank every single one of you who supports Cesta domů in a variety of ways.

Thank you for helping us to change the way people die in the Czech Republic.

DIRECT SERVICES

Cesta domů operates six direct services that are interconnected and allow us to provide comprehensive care for the terminally ill and dying and their loved ones.

There was a big change in direct services at the beginning of 2018, when mobile specialised palliative care was added to the list of services covered by public health insurance, i.e. the payment of the health component of a comprehensive hospice service. After fifteen years of trying to include this type of care in the healthcare system, this was a fundamental moment and

the culmination of a pilot programme conducted in cooperation with Všeobecná zdravotní pojišťovna (General Health Insurance Company) and the Ministry of Health for the past three years. Following negotiations with individual insurance companies, Cesta domů has been a contractual provider of home palliative care for all domestic health insurance companies since September 2018. This allows us to use health insurance to cover part of our comprehensive services. The inclusion of a patient in payment through public health insurance is always decided by a doctor based on indication criteria and other factors (for example, prognosis, the use of care from other providers, etc.), some patients are included only over the course of time. Only about half of our patients meet the criteria; therefore, we continue to use donations from individual and corporate donors and grants from state and non-governmental organisations to cover our services.

A new service is the palliative and supportive care home visit service that we set up in April 2018. This involves a visit by a doctor to an adult or child patient's home where the doctor considers the possible palliative procedures associated with advanced disease and helps set up medication. So far, we have been a contracting provider for this service for four health insurance companies in 2018, and we are negotiating with others.

Direct services are run by Karolína Pochmanová.

Medical services

Our team of doctors and nurses provides terminally ill children and adults in their home with 24-hour, 7-day-a-week health care focussing on treatment for pain and associated symptoms.

In 2018 we took care of 325 patients and the number of treatment days was 5,940. We had 11 child patients in our care, one of whom lived in the Central Bohemia Region. We cooperate with Motol University Hospital and the U Apolináře Gynaecological and Obstetric Clinic on the transfer of paediatric patients.

We try to take acute patients so that they can spend the last few days of their lives at home. In the course of the year, we managed to reduce the response time to writing out a request for admission to mobile hospice care. After filling out a request in the counselling centre, the family is contacted by an outpatient nurse who, depending on how acute the patient's condition is and on capacity, arranges an outpatient visit or admission to hospice care. We also cooperate with hospitals to transfer patients directly to our care.

The newly established palliative care home visit service in 2018 made 148 visits to patients' own social environment. Several times we also visited patients in hospital. A doctor visits the patient and sets up a care plan and symptom treatment according to the wishes of the patient and his or her family. For some patients, after the medication has been set up and the family has been given instructions, the service enabled them to spend the end of their lives at home and without the involvement of mobile hospice care.

The medical team is headed by MUDr. Irena Závadová. In addition to her, in 2018 it consisted of 3 regular doctors and 7 nurses. Pavel Klimeš is in charge of the team of nurses. The BLÍŽKSOBĚ Foundation, Lesy České republiky and Opportunus were important partners of the mobile hospice medical team.

The increase in the number of patients in hospice care in 2018 compared to the previous year can be attributed to the fact that thanks to the adjustment of internal procedures we are able to respond more quickly to submitted care requests. The new ambulance service also plays a role. One-off treatment with an ambulance visit is enough for some patients – thanks to a well-set up plan for future care and symptom treatment, the family can handle everything without having to be taken into our care, with the assistance of a general practitioner and perhaps a home care agency. Alternatively, the family will only use hospice care just before the patient's death.

The median length of care for child patients is much higher than in adult patients, which is consistent with global data. This is confirmed by our assumption and the reason why it has been agreed for health insurance coverage that children may be included in it for longer than adults (90 vs. 30 days).

* The number of child patients was not recorded in these years.

Counselling

Counselling staff provide free professional social counselling to anyone in the Czech Republic who is interested, who is caring for someone dying in their home or who wants to prepare to look after someone. They also offer help to people who are coming to terms with the loss of a loved one.

Consultations take place by telephone and in person. During 2018, the staff carried out an average of 68 consultations a week. They also responded to questions in the internet counselling centre at Umirani.cz, where 483 queries were received during the year. The counselling centre is also the place where we fill out requests with applicants for admission to the mobile hospice and respite services.

The counselling team consists of six social workers. The counselling centre is led by Veronika Drnková, who, thanks to the Avast Foundation Palliative Care Scholarship, in 2018 trained in the USA in the method of complicated grief therapy and the counselling centre will be offering this therapy to grieving relatives from 2019.

Support team

Our clients and their families are provided with psychosocial and spiritual support by psychosocial workers, psychologists, a psychotherapist and a chaplain, who are members of the support team. Their aim is to guide sick people, the people caring for them and grieving relatives through the administrative and emotional burden associated with the situation they find themselves in. Throughout the year, we have strengthened the role of the chaplain, who increasingly offers to talk to families about existential issues, and possibly also about organising a farewell ritual. He has also begun to hold regular spiritual meetings for our employees and volunteers.

The support team now includes two child psychotherapists who are available to both sick children and to their siblings or the children of someone who is dying or has died in the care of Cesta domů. Care is always limited by the number of consultations and is aimed at coping with the loss. As the number of patients has increased, there has been a need for more capacity for survivors. We provide them with a visit, and they can also be guided through their grief individually or use the safe place to share during the Podvečer Club meetings, which are held once a month in the Cesta domů library.

In 2018, our psychosocial workers devoted 840 hours of direct care to clients.

The support team was led in 2018 by Jindřiška Prokopová.

Respite services

Respite services are provided by Cesta domů as a matter of priority to receivers of palliative care, and then depending on the capacity, to other long-term and terminally ill people of all ages. In 2018, respite services have complemented our hospice care to a greater extent than in previous years. New clients were hospice patients or were indicated during a home visit. Greater interconnection between respite services and hospice care has resulted in a slight increase in the average number of clients at any one time, as well as a significant reduction in the median length of care compared to the previous year. In total, respite assistants devoted 5,602 hours of care to 107 clients.

Nine respite assistants led by Martina Tesařová work in the respite service team.

Volunteers

Volunteers are essential in making our organisation function. They participate in activities in many areas, from administration to direct care. They come from different backgrounds and have diverse knowledge and skills, complementing and enriching our team.

In 2018, 102 volunteers devoted 7,222 hours of their time. Most of all, volunteer work was needed in our two charity shops, where volunteers not only sold items but also provided information about Cesta domů's services, a total of 3,579 hours. Volunteers with special training helped in the families of hospice clients with 132 visits, totalling 605 hours. They also assisted respite service clients, with whom they spent a total of 116 hours. Volunteers made 204 trips with adjustable beds and other aids. They also spent hundreds of hours more providing administrative support, helping to organise Cesta domů events and going on errands. Volunteers have now also started to help in our café.

We were delighted when Věra Lucey, who works as a volunteer in direct care, was given the Křesadlo Award by the Hestia organisation. 2018 saw the start of the 16th volunteer training cycle, which is necessary for visiting clients' families.

The volunteer coordinator is Markéta Novotná.

In 2018, the volunteer programme was supported by Dobrobazar, z.s.



Sometimes, after I have been volunteering I think how strange it is that life is so normal up until the end – that, just like normal, people communicate, look, love some things, dislike other things, are polite, want to entertain visitors, enjoy the ordinary little things, and say goodbye with "see you soon". So normal, and then it's over.

Equipment rental

The main purpose of medical equipment rental is to provide families in hospice care with compensatory aids to help maintain patient dignity and facilitate home care. We also offer rental services to the public.

In the course of the year, the rental service made 400 trips, mainly with adjustable beds (100 of these trips were for the public and 300 trips were to families in the care of Cesta domů). We lent a total of 2,050 pieces of equipment. In total, 617 clients used these services. In 2018, the rental service focussed on renewing and improving the quality of the equipment offered and on purchasing additional adjustable beds, also thanks to significant support from Cushman & Wakefield and DMA Praha.

Equipment rental is run by Otto Adamec.

EDUCATION AND SHARING EXPERIENCES

Cesta domů is constantly trying to contribute to the development of palliative care in the Czech Republic through its educational and awareness activities. We provide professional one-day and multiple-day study visits for doctors, nurses, and social workers, as well as study visits for doctors in postgraduate training. For groups of people who are interested, we organise educational days consisting of lectures and workshops prepared by members of our multidisciplinary team. We are approached to participate in lectures and other events for the specialist and general public, we focus on selected topics to do with palliative care and, for example, we help to support the efforts of other entities to promote mobile palliative care.

Study visits and lecturing

In 2018, 44 experts from other organisations made study visits to Cesta domů, totalling 88 days. We organised three study days to present our multidisciplinary care to paediatricians, home care agency staff and students of caring disciplines. Our staff lectured for 96 hours to 1,300 participants during the year.

Cesta domů was able to continue in its educational and awareness activities in 2018 thanks to the support of the Komerční banka – Jistota Foundation and the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs.

Library

The Cesta domů library is for anyone interested in literature about the end of human life – professionals, students and readers from the general public.

The collection of 4,270 titles includes not only professional books on medical, nursing and psychosocial subjects, but also relevant fiction and audiobooks. In 2018, we added nearly 450 new titles, namely 218, mainly professional books, and largely foreign-language, and 219 spoken word CDs.

MEETING AND COMMUNICATING WITH THE PUBLIC

Strengthening the awareness that dying is a natural and important part of life remains one of our important tasks. We strive to provide comprehensive information to those who urgently need it – at Umirani.cz we offer advice and information on the care of the terminally ill, Internet counselling, discussion and thematic articles. The knowledge of the staff on our team is often used by journalists, which means we can help to bring health and psychosocial aspects of palliative care to the public through online and printed articles, television and radio reports and interviews. We have also been involved in advocacy activities. As part of a Fulbright-Masaryk Scholarship Lenka Váňová undertook a four-month internship at the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization, which brings together and represents providers of hospice and palliative care across the USA. She has summarised her experience in an online guide available on the Cesta domů website. We also try to make finality and death in everyday life less of a taboo by participating in public discussions, through the distribution of our publications and by organising events.

Meeting donors and supporters in person

At the end of spring, we regularly organise a social evening for donors and supporters of Cesta domů. In 2018 it was held in the Ledebur Garden beneath Prague Castle. During the evening, guests could meet the Cesta domů staff and enjoy listening to the Sugarcutes vocal quartet. They could also see the latest publications or go on a guided tour of the gardens.

At the beginning of September, we used our café in Soukenická Street to host a breakfast for our donors and supporters. Thanks to cooperation with The Prague Concert Co., we were also able to invite those, without whom our activities would not be possible, to a concert by the renowned El Camino Youth Symphony from California.

At the beginning of October, we joined in with the Week for Mobile Hospices campaign with "Slippers Day" and helped spread the idea of home hospice care in the media and on social networks.

Concert

Cesta domů traditionally joins in the celebrations of World Hospice and Palliative Care Day, which is held every year on the second Saturday in October. At our concert at La Fabrika in Prague on October 11th, Barbora Poláková sang with her band in front of a sold-out auditorium. The performance was enjoyed by everyone and we were able to introduce new people to the idea of hospice care.

Benefit auction

A popular part of the autumn programme for donors and art lovers is our benefit auction, which was held for the eighth year in the grand setting of the Congress Hall in the Hilton Prague, the main partner of the auction. The collection of 151 works consisted of a selection of Czech and Slovak fine and applied art.

During the evening, works were auctioned off for CZK 1,328,900. During the auction, we also broke the barrier of CZK 10 million received during all previous auctions. Some of the works

were auctioned online on the Cesta domů website for CZK 266,000. The total proceeds from the auction, including sales after the auction, amounted to CZK 1,850,900.

The benefit auction was organised by Lucie Mikulecká and Karolína Drábková under the leadership of Helena Štohanzlová.

Online communication with the public

The Cestadomucz website recorded on average 330 visits a day from 208 users. The Umirani.cz information services were used by an average of 1,063 users a day, from whom we recorded 1,456 visits. During the year, we published 15 original articles on the Umirani.cz portal and the website was nominated for the Křišťálová Lupa Award in the Public Benefit Service section – the Czech Television Award. The portal was supported by Amgen.

We acquired almost a thousand new fans on Facebook during the year, reaching 11,378 by 31 December. 950 users followed us on Twitter. On our website you can subscribe to the Kaleidoskop electronic monthly, which contains news from our activities and the latest information about hospice and palliative care.

Lenka Váňová and Linda Tichotová Fryčová were in charge of coordinating programmes and communication with the public in 2018.



FINANCE AND FUNDRAISING

Cesta domů is able to provide its services and develop further thanks to the support of donors. We are always pleased, and we do not take it for granted that each year there are over two thousand people and more than a hundred corporate partners, for whom the subject of a dignified end of life is at the forefront of their minds. We very much appreciate every crown they donate. We are pleased to be in contact with them every day and to bring them closer to events not only at Cesta domů, but also, in general, in the field of palliative care in the Czech Republic and elsewhere in the world.

The feeling that we can rely on a large group of people, companies and institutions is crucial to us, including in a situation where, after years of efforts, a decree containing an instrument for the payment of the health component of our comprehensive hospice service has come into force. Although Cesta domů has signed contracts with all health insurance companies for this performance, only a portion of our patients are indicated for reimbursement. Therefore, we are not ceasing in our efforts to obtain additional financial resources to cover all our activities, which consist of trying to change the view of palliative care in this country and to fulfil the wishes of the severely ill to depart in peace, to be with their family and where they are happiest.

The Cesta domů budget is made up of donations from individual and corporate donors, contributions from endowment funds and foundations, subsidies from the state budget, profits from our own activities, and benefit events. Cesta domů's general partner is the AVAST Foundation. Thanks to all the donors!

- In 2018, members of the Friends of Cesta domů Club and regular donors gave us more than 5.4 million CZK.
- The total income from all individual donors (regular and occasional) was 9.33 million CZK.
- Corporate donors donated 3.5 million CZK.

From September to November 2018, we took care of an eight-year-old boy with acute leukaemia after a failed bone marrow transplant. Care was more complicated, blood counts had to be checked often, red blood cell and platelet transfusions had to be repeated frequently in the hospital, and controls and transfusions had to be arranged with the hospital. Our care helped the family to be sure that they can cope with everything,

that they have someone they can turn to day and night. We used the possibility of payment for specialised palliative care from the insurance company, but thanks to our donors we were sure that even if the insurance company did not want to pay for the care, we would be able to provide it without any worries. The public health insurance reimbursement mechanism in 2018 did not allow a patient to be in the care of two facilities at the same time - in this case, that the boy could undergo a transfusion in the hospital and at the same time be cared for by Cesta domů. Either the boy would have to be in hospital or just at home without any transfusions, which would clearly accelerate his death. After the transfusions, when he felt much better, he could go home and really enjoy the time he had - with his older brother, with his parents and grandparents, with their dog and his new Lego.

Thanks to our donors, when caring for our patients we can freely decide with the sole aim of allowing them and their families to spend their last moments together as best they can.

SELECTED PROJECTS IN 2018

Professionalisation of Cesta domů, ESF - Operational Programme Employment

In 2018, a project focused on the internal development and professionalisation of Cesta domů continued – further professional seminars from the Management Academy were held focussing on time management, project management, budgeting, development and feedback interviews with subordinates, etc. In addition to the Management Academy, individual consultations with experts on human resources, budgeting, fundraising and quality of service took place.

Programme to support non-governmental non-profit organisations operating in the health sector, including palliative hospice care, Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic

Thanks to support, we have been able to expand our portfolio with four more publications. In the new edition of booklets on the death of a child, we have published the first two publications – entitled *Our Baby Has Died* and *Our Child's Sibling Has Died*. Furthermore, we have re-edited the well-proven, ten-page leaflet *Children Mourn Differently* and have recently prepared and published a leaflet taking into account the important and sometimes neglected fact that teenagers are a separate category – *Teenagers Mourn In Their Own Way*. Thanks to the project, we have also expanded the range of rental equipment by adding five new items and as an investment we have bought a portable ultrasound.




Coordination of Multidisciplinary Home Hospice Care, Operational Programme Employment, Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs of the Czech Republic

The provider of home palliative care at Cesta domů is the multidisciplinary team. It encompasses health and social services and forms a functional unit to provide terminally ill and dying people and those close to them with comprehensive care with an emphasis on the quality of their lives at home 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The project focuses on systemic improvement of multidisciplinary team coordination, which will bring further improvement, streamlining and completeness of the services that are offered.

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SUPPLEMENT

ProCestu s.r.o. service organisation



In 2018, ProCestu s.r.o. service organisation continued to run the charity shops, the Cesta domů publishers and the café. Away from premises, the lease of an office and warehouse at Bubenská 421/3, Prague 7, where the service organisation has its headquarters, was also taken out in the second half of the year. The Managing Director of the service organisation is Vojtěch Kozlík.

Cesta domů publishers

In 2018, we produced 18 publications, including 8 re-editions or other editions. There were three new books for children, two of them were original Czech books and one was translated from Norwegian. Overall, including invitations, leaflets and stationery, we produced about 90 different prints. The publishers had the same team as last year. And again this year, publications have been co-financed from grants, donations and advertisements. Many thanks go to the donors, without whom the books could not be published. They supported the publishing house with half a million crowns, which is almost 20% more than in the previous year.

We published our first novel, *The Love Song of Miss Queenie Hennessy* by Rachel Joyce. *I Can't Sleep* by Stein Erik Lunde and the typographically unusual *The Secret* by Martina Špinková are interesting children's books. We helped expand the palliative library for experts and laymen with the book *Drip, Catheter, Horn* by the Australian anaesthesiologist Ken Hillman.

Thanks to grants, it has been possible to donate some of the publications to hospices and other service providers throughout the country. We sell most of the books through large distributors

and nearly 40 smaller commission agents. We also sell books ourselves in two shops, in the café and on an e-shop, as well as at all the major book fairs, at three palliative conferences and several dozen other events. Thanks to trips, we have the opportunity to receive feedback from readers and librarians, psychologists and health professionals from many parts of the country.

Cesta domů charity shops

Cesta domů has two charity shops. The shop near the Vltavská metro station is the larger of the two and also works as the headquarters, ordering merchandise and making arrangements for events. The shop on Bělohorská Street is in a quieter part of the city and visitors are mostly local and they often return to the shop. In both stores we sell goods from the publishers, including creative stationery, as well as various gifts and clothing.

An important event for the shops in 2018 was the first year of the Cabinet of Curiosities, an evening organised at the Archa Barista Café. The inspiration came from volunteers, the goal was to offer the most interesting and valuable items donated to the shops. Among the other largest events that we organised or participated in were our two JakPak bazaars in the spring, which we organised at Kampus Hybernská, and the Dyzajn market and Lemarket in Prague.

Volunteers worked 3,579 hours in the shops in 2018. They not only sell merchandise but also communicate with people who come to get information about care or seek comfort while they are mourning.

The Cesta domů café

The café was operating for a second full year in 2018. It was designed as a quiet working place with good fair & bio coffee and soup and as a nice place to meet people and get information about Cesta domů. The premises were used for work and social events, one separate room was offered for rent. Exhibitions were held throughout the year in the café and collaboration with the Samaří Club, which held lectures here, continued. Events in the café in 2018 were supported by a grant from Prague City Hall, which meant that, among other things, an exhibition coordinator could be employed. An average of ten events were held in the café each month (readings by Martin Myšička, book launches, literary workshops for children, training sessions, press conferences, private viewings, volunteer meetings, parties, private celebrations). During the year there were 9 exhibitions and 10 lectures in cooperation with the Samaří Club.
